Project Description	 MERC, in partnership with Kinross Gold Corp., is seeking a MSc student to undertake a research project beginning in summer 2025. The Great Bear deposit is a new world-class gold deposit located in the Red Lake greenstone belt in northwestern Ontario. The property, owned by Kinross Gold Corporation, is bisected by a fault that bounds the so-called Mafic and Felsic domains. Existing research conducted in the Felsic domain of the Great Bear property has demonstrated that the stratigraphy hosting gold mineralization is younger than other established gold deposits in the nearby Red Lake gold camp. These results potentially provide evidence for a second major mineralization event in the greenstone belt. The proposed research, which aims to complement existing research in the Felsic domain, will investigate the petrogenetic origins and the emplacement of volcanic rocks and intrusions in the Mafic domain of the Great Bear property. The successful applicant will conduct detailed outcrop mapping and extensive core logging of representative sections in order to constrain the stratigraphy and emplacement of the volcanic succession. These constraints will form the basis for sampling for whole-rock lithogeochemistry and U-Pb zircon geochronology by TIMS or LA-ICPMS. These results will provide important temporal constraints and help resolve whether the stratigraphy in the Mafic domain is conformable with the Felsic domain. The project is funded through a partnership with Kinross Gold Corp. and NSERC and will be supervised by Dr. Stefanie Brueckner and the Kinross Gold technical team.
