CALL FOR ABSTRACTS AND POSTERS



On **Tuesday 5 March 2019**, the **PDAC**, the **SEG Canada Foundation**, the **Mineral Exploration Research Centre**, and the **Goodman School of Mines** in cooperation with Student Leaders from the **Laurentian University** and **Ottawa-Carleton Geoscience Centre SEG Student Chapters** will host the Annual “**Student Minerals Colloquium**” in Room 701 of the Metro Toronto Convention Centre (MTCC) South Building. The Colloquium will include more than 85 poster presentations highlighting current research on mineral deposits and related studies by students across North America.

All students (BSc, MSc, PhD) working on projects with a link to mineral deposits (e.g. mapping, mineralogy, geochemistry, geophysics, environmental, hydrogeology, etc.) are encouraged to participate. This event attracts hundreds of industry participants who are attending PDAC and therefore provides the widest-possible exposure for your work.

Abstracts

All posters must be written in English, and accompanied by an abstract, which will be published on the PDAC-SEG Student Minerals Colloquium webpage in a format that is citable. Abstracts must be under 400 words.

Abstracts will be reviewed and only those that are free of errors will be accepted, so students should prepare their abstracts well ahead of time and have their Supervisors review them. Abstracts must be submitted online at <https://merc.laurentian.ca/seg-smc> by **midnight on Sunday 13 January 2019**, late submissions will be placed on a wait list, reviewed and included only if there is space, and will not be eligible for prizes.

Posters

Posters must be designed to fit inside a 45” high x 90” long poster panel (maximum dimensions) and should be affixed with Velcro® hook material that will permit them to be affixed to felt-covered boards.

Posters must be put up **between 08:00 and 10:00 am** on **Tuesday 5 March 2019** and **MUST NOT**, under any circumstances, be taken down **before 6 pm** that evening.

The senior student author **MUST** be present between **3 pm** and **6 pm** on **Tuesday, 5 March 2019**. Cash prizes will be awarded only to students who are present during that time interval. See details of the 2018 event at <http://cmic-footprints.ca/smc/>.
